use these questions for further study

Pray the Lord's Prayer together or individually to begin the time (Mtt 6:9-13).

Read John 3:1-21

What are some initial observations about Nicodemus and this interaction he has with Jesus?

What is something you experience every day, like the wind, that you don't fully understand?

Is there something you feel you should understand about God but don't?

Does knowing the context around John 3:16 give you any deeper insights into this powerful verse?

How is Jesus being lifted up on the cross like Moses lifting up the serpent in Numbers 21:7-9 (read if you'd like a refresher)?

How can we "come to the light" in our daily lives and seek to avoid living in darkness?

Read John 7:45-52

Have you have felt convicted to speak up in a work or other public setting for Jesus? Did you do so? How did it go if so?

Read John 19:38-42

What do you notice about how Nicodemus and Joseph demonstrate faith in Jesus boldly here?

What kind of emotions do you think they would have been feeling as they did so?

What stands out to you about the trajectory of Nicodemus and his discipleship of Jesus?

Have you ever talked to someone about something you are unsure of or are wrestling with about God? What can make this difficult for us to do?

How can we remind ourselves and others that following Jesus is a process?

How can we intentionally seek to journey with Jesus together with others?

Have you ever "taken a stand" for God in your life? What are some ways we can prepare ourselves to do so when we have opportunities?

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
