Why was Phillip excited about Jesus?

Why was Nathanael hesitant to believe Phillip's claim about Jesus?

Was his skepticism necessarily cynical or unfounded? Why/why not?

How does Phillip respond to Nathanael's doubts?

What can their interaction teach us about effective evangelism?

What does Jesus say when he meets Nathanael?

What does this tell us about Nathanael?

Why does it provoke such a strong response of faith?

Read Genesis 28:10-17

What does this Old Testament story have to do with Jesus' words to Nathanael?

What is the meaning of the imagery Jesus is using?

How does Jesus alter the image?

What claim is Jesus making here? What does it mean?

Consider what Pastor Adam said about disciples. That disciples: Follow Jesus, Make Disciples, Study Scripture, are Found by Jesus.

Is there one of these areas you need to press into? Which? Why? What practical steps can you take to live more fully as a disciple?
