1. Did you have a nickname growing up? Did you have a reputation that you tried to change?
 2. In what ways might building a reputation have influenced you as an adult, and what actions has that desired reputation prompted you to take? (If you are honest, what would you like to be known for?)
 3. Read the account of the Last Supper from Luke 22:14-34.
 - a. Vs 21-24
 - i. Why do you think Jesus announced that his betrayer was sitting at the table, but didn't say who it was?
 - ii. What does it say about Judas that he wasn't the obvious choice for a betrayer?
 - lii. How might that have led the way to the discussion about who was the greatest?
 - b. Vs 25-27
 - i. What is the difference between healthy self confidence and healthy humility?
 - ii. How might Jesus' view of greatness tear into our deepest need for recognition?
 - c. Vs 28-32
 - i. Compare what Jesus promised his 12 disciples with the description of the temple in the New Jerusalem in Revelation 21:14.
 - ii. What does this tell us about God's ultimate plan for the apostles?
 - lii. What conclusion can we come to about spiritual failure in light of Peter and the other disciples' failures during Jesus' arrest and crucifixion?

 - a. In our current "rights conscious" culture, where do you see the biggest struggles as we "stand up for our rights"?
 - b. What questions come up for us as Christians in this culture, and how do we address these questions?

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
